New admission system in primary schools will hit UPEP

LAKSHMIPUR, Jan. 26.—The new admission system in the Primary Schools will hamper the achievement of government goal of education for all within the year 2000, the guardians apprehended.

According to new system, the government has taken decision to permit the children to be admitted to the class one of any primary school at the age of seven only below the age of 7. no child is permitted to be admitted.

The headmasters of the primary schools said that they had to show cause to the government for admitting students below the age of 7.

This policy has generated resent-

ment among the guardians who said that the government has declared the policy of achieving 100 per cent mass education within the year 200 and at the same time the govt. decision will spoil two years in the life of a student.

The guardians urged the government to review the decision.
