Pry school for Saudi children in city

The Saudi Embassy started its own primary school for the Saudi children in Dhaka. This is the first school for the Arab-speaking children in Bangladesh.

Saudi Charge d'Affaires Mr. Ali Ahmed Abdal Wahab inaugurated the school at the Saudi Embassy's permanent site at Baridhara Diplomatic Enclave on Saturday.

Started with 20 children of the Saudi diplomats the primary school will give intensive teaching on religion and it will follow the Saudi curriculum. The embassy has a plan to further expand the facilities of the school when it might consider to teach children of diplomats of other Arab countries.

Mr. Ibrahim Al-Ashban, an experienced teacher from Saudi Arabia, will act as the Director of the school and two Saudi teachers, Mohammad Al-Ghamdi and Mohammad Al-Qasem, have been appointed for the school.

Inaugurating the school, the Saudi Charge d'Affaires said that the institution fulfilled the long-felt need of an exclusive school for the Saudi children in Dhaka. He informed that the Saudi Club near the school started a library with valuable books on Islam and Arabic culture which would help the scholars, research fellows and ulema.
