## 41 pry. school teachers not getting salary

**KHAGRACHARI, Sept. 20:**  
Forty-one primary school teachers appointed by the Local Govt. Parishad, Khagrachari, have been leading a miserable life due to non-payment of salary and allowances for last five months:

It is noted that after the transfer of primary education to the Local Govt. Parishad by the Govt. Khagrachari Local Govt. Parishad appointed 85 teachers to the vacant posts in different schools of eight thanas of the district in the month of April this year. Out of them, 82 teachers joined their posts duly. Out of 82 teachers 41 teachers in four thanas, namely, Khagrachari sadar, Pandari, Mahal-dari and Dighinab are now getting their salary after movement launched by the teachers concerned. The other 41 teachers in the other four thanas Matiranga, Lazmichari, Rangarh and Manikchari are not getting salary since their appointment.

Under the pressure of the concerned district authority, though the thana education officers sent the salary bills of the concerning teachers to the treasury for necessary action, the Treasury officers did not pass the bills assingning various excuses. No action to remove complicity in the payment of salary of the teachers is not taken by the authority concerned even after five months of their appointment.

The newly appointed primary school teachers have become very much frustrated. Concerned authorities should look into the matter without further delay, it is expected by all.
