Khaleda asks JCD leaders Maintain peace on campus

Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia on Friday advised the members of the Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) to help maintain academic atmosphere on the campus and build themselves as educated, honest and patriotic citizens to take up the future leadership of the country, reports BSS.
