DUTA for congenial atmosphere on campus

The newly elected office bearers of Dhaka University Teachers' Association (DUTA) at a meeting on Friday called upon all quarters to maintain congenial academic atmosphere in the university showing respect to the university rules.

Presided over by DUTA President Prof. AFM Yousuf Haider, the meeting discussed the present situation of the university that arises out of an "indecent behaviour of a teacher with a female student of the university" extensively and demanded punishment to the teachers as per the rules of the university if anybody is found guilty by the probe body.

The meeting said that nobody should create turmoil in the university before publishing of the inquiry committee report regarding the incident. "Dhaka University is the highest seat of learning in the country so every body has the responsibility to protect the image and dignity of the university," the meeting observed.
