ID card check in DU halls peaceful

An emergency meeting of the Standing Committee of the Provosts of Dhaka University halls on Monday monitored the progress of the checking of Identity Cards of the students entering the different halls.

Presided over by the Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University Prof A.K. Azad Chowdhury, the meeting viewed that there was no unpleasant situation and all the halls remained peaceful.

The drive for checking of Identity Cards began in all the eleven halls of male students on Sunday and it will continue for another week. Earlier, the drive for checking of Identity Cards was undertaken only in four halls of the university. The three women's halls of the varsity have been debarred from checking.

The meeting resolved that Laminated Identity Cards would be issued to all the resident students by June 15 in order to check the influx of outsiders and terrorists into the dormitories. The university authority will also ensure the return of those students to their respective halls who were victimised politically by their opponents earlier.

The Vice-Chancellor visited all the halls late last night while the Provosts were also present at their respective halls during the night.

The general students welcomed the drive and also heaved a sigh of relief following the drive for checking Identity Cards of the students. The university authority also decided to issue Identity Cards to all the students soon. The varsity authority hoped that all political parties students' organisations and guardians will continue to extend their cooperation to restore normalcy on the campus of the university.
