## Ban on student politics in IU further extended

ISLAMIC UNIVERSITY (Kush-tia), Jan 2:—Authorities of Islamic University extended the duration of ban on political activities on the campus in an emergency meeting with the leaders of various students organisations of IU Thursday. The IU authorities decided to maintain the ban upto February 17 due to cultural competition, annual athletics admission test and examinations for the honours and masters courses of various departments. IU authorities will meet with the leaders of student leader organisations on February 18 after concluding the extended period to decide the fate of the future ban on campus politics. The meeting was attended by the leaders of Chhatra League (S-P), Chhatra Dal (JCD), Chhatra Shibir, Chhatra Moitri, Chhatra Front and pro JSD Chhatra League while Vice Chancellor Prof Inam Ul Hoque was the chair. Ban on political activities on the IU campus has been prevailing since November 9 following a bloody clash between Chhatra League (S-P) and Chhatra Shibir on September 26 killing one and over a hundred and fifty student were injured.
