12-pt demand Govt college teachers seek PM's intervention

Leaders of Bangladesh Government College Professors' Samity and Bangladesh Government College Lecturers' Samity on Friday expressed resentment over the Government's reluctance in implementing their 12-point demand and sought Prime Minister's intervention in this respect.

In a statement, they said that a number of meetings were held with Education Minister and Secretary and every time they assured to meet the teachers' demands. But it is very regrettable that no effective steps were taken in this respect till today due to the bureaucratic complicity, they added.

The 12-point demand of the government college teachers include promotion of lecturers, assistant professors and associate professors and higher wage scale, retrospective seniority of affected teachers and creation of posts in 233 colleges.

The next course of action programme will be announced at a meeting to be held today (Saturday) at Mymensingh Ananda Mohan University College premises. Government College Professors' Samity President Prof. Kamal Ataur Rahman will preside over the meeting, says a Press release.
