## Yellow panel sweeps RUTA elections

RAJSHAHI, Jan. 7.—Yellow panel backed by Awami League and a faction of BNP swept all the posts excluding only Vice-President in the election of 15-member Executive Council of Rajshahi University Teacher's Association (RUTA) held today defeating Jamaal-e-Islami and another faction of BNP backed teachers' "Green panel."

The yellow panel also swept all the 49 posts excluding only one Dean of 18-member Syndicate, Dean, Academic Council, Planning and Development Committees of the University in election held today.

Those who captured four out of six faculty Dean posts from yellow panel are: Prof Mizan Uddin (Social Science), Prof M Faqrul Islam (Science), Prof M Abdul Khaleque (Life and Earth Science) and Prof M Shah Nawaz Ali (Business and Commerce) while Prof. A K M Yakub Ali was elected Dean of Arts Faculty from Green panel and Prof Fayed Uddin captured the post of Dean of Law Faculty as an independent candidate.

Five elected Syndicate members are: Prof Entazul Haque, Prof M Saidur Rahman Khan, M Habibur Rahman Akan, Dr M Saiful Islam Faruqui and M Ilias Hossain.

Six elected members to the Academic Council are: Syed Shamsuddin Ahmed, M Wazed Ali Pramanik, M Zamsed Ali Sarker, M Saiful Islam, Syed M Ziauddin and Khan-daker Imamul Haque.

Prof M Abdul Jalil Mian of Chemistry Department was elected member of Planning and Development Committee.

A total of 558 teachers out of 650 cast their votes in the election held at Zebery Bhaban (RU Teacher's Club) from 8:30 am to 1.30 p.m. today.
