

Reopening of DU demanded

Students Against Repression, the platform that led the recent student outburst, on Wednesday demonstrated on Dhaka University campus demanding immediate reopening of the university.

They also demanded full implementation of their seven-point charter, administrative action against the attackers on the demonstrating students, immediate publication of the full report of judicial inquiry commission.

The students brought out a procession and held a rally in front of Central Library. Prior to the rally they staged a cultural presentation.

Speakers at the rally demanded publication of the full-fledged report of judicial probe body and said there was no scope of avoiding the liabilities of the former VC and Proctor. All in the previous administration were equally liable for the incidents as police can not enter the campus without their previous permission, they added.

They condemned the attack on the demonstrating students on DU campus and the joint attack on the students of Rajshahi University by police and ruling BNP's student wing Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD).
