BUET students rally against terrorism

A peaceful strike was observed on Saturday at the Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET) at the call of all-party student unity (APSU) of BUET in protest against the attack on Ashiqur Rahman Asif, Indoor games secretary of EUCSU, by a group of armed miscreants on the campus on Wednesday.

The students brought out a silent procession which paraded around the campus and submitted a memorandum to Prof. M. Shahjahan, Vice-Chancellor of BUET demanding trial and exemplary punishment to the attackers to restore congenial atmosphere.

Addressing the gathering Prof. Md. Shahjahan, Vice-Chancellor of BUET thanked the students for their "timely" stand against terrorism and assured them that he would take necessary steps against those responsible for the attack on Asif.

It may be mentioned that a group of youths including a BUET student stabbed Arif, a third year student of Naval Architecture Department and indoor games secretary of EUCSU on March 5 when he did not allow them to attend a charity concert without ticket.

Meanwhile, 748 students of BUET in a joint statement on Saturday demanded punishment to the attackers of Asif.

The students criticised the EUCSU and university authorities for what they said silent role over the incident.
