

Anomaly in pry. school book distribution alleged

COMILLA, Mar. 5:—Delay, anamoly and irregularities in the distribution of books have created scope for the book sellers who are trading books at the cost of thousands of Primary school students, it is alledged.

Though the stock of books is more than the Primary School students in the district, anamoly and irregularities in distributing has created an artificial crisis of books and compelled the guardians to buy books from open markets at exorbitnat prices.

According to an official source, the total number of students in all six classes including pre-one class in 1332 Govt. Primary Schools and 199 Non-Govt Schools is 4.65 lakh but the total number of books meant for distribution free of cost available for distribution is 5.57 lakh sets including 55,300 sets of last year's stock. But an artificial crisis of Primary school books has been created compelling the guardians to procure the books from market at exorbitant price. Delay and anamolies in distribution of Primary books has created the present situation it is alledged. Many of the Non-Govt

Primary School students did not get any books and in same Govt. Primary Schools money is being realised from the students in the name of conveyance, it is alleged.

Threat to widow

A widow subjected to threats and atrocities by a group of criminals after she lodged a case against them for murdering her husband, it is alleged.

One Shafiqur Rhman (27) of village Sreepur under Bhulain Union in Laksam Upazila was murdered alledgedly by his enemies in the night, following January 31. He was suffocated to death. His wife despite threats on her life and chestity instituted a case in the court of Upazila Magistrate against 7 persons.

After institution of the case the accused persons have took away a pair of bullocks belonging to late Shafiq worth Taka 15,000 and mortgaged his lands at Taka 20,000.
