Govt college teachers to go for work abstention from April 2

The teachers of B.C.S. General Education cadre working at 233 government colleges and offices will go for nonstop work abstention from April 2 if their 16-point demands are not met by March 22.

Dr. Q.A.T.M. Habibur Rahman and Md. Abu Yusuf, President and Secretary General of the association respectively in a statement on Saturday said that the Ministry of Education had fixed several dates to implement their demand but did not materialise the demands.

They said this time they would go for greater movement to achieve their demands.

Meanwhile six non-government teachers organisations formed a Central Teachers Action Liaison Committee. The committee will announce a programme for movement after Eid-ul-Fitr to achieve their demands including pay scale for non-government teachers and staff, implementation of recommendations of special committee and to frame the service security rule for non-government teachers and staff.

A meeting of the liaison committee was held at Sheikh Borhanuddin College on Thursday under the chairmanship of Sheikh Amanullah.
