

APSU demands implementation of 10-point demand

The All-Party Student Unity in a statement urged the elected representatives of the fifth Jatiya Sangsad to introduce a system of government in which the Government will remain accountable to the parliament aiming at ending autocratic rule in the country. The APSU called for establishing a sovereign parliament.

The All-Party Student Unity urged the Parliament to separate judiciary from the executive to ensure independence of judiciary. The APSU also called for repealing all amendments to the constitution which were

made to dominate over the judiciary by the executive. It demanded repeal for all black laws repugnant to the fundamental rights including the Special Powers Act. It also demanded autonomy for all the Government media. The APSU demanded implementation of all the commitments made by the three alliances in the joint declaration.

The APSU said that a great responsibility was entrusted on the fifth Jatiya Sangsad to bring a radical change in the autocratic administrative system and transition to democracy. It hoped that the fifth Jatiya Sangsad would play a vital role in fulfilling the hopes and aspiration of the people who made sacrifice during the anti-autocracy movement. It also hoped that the Sangsad would make efforts to implement 10-point demand of the All-Party Student Unity.
