

DU Hons admission

60,000 applications for 4,000 seats

A total of 60 thousand application forms have been submitted against four thousand Dhaka University seats on Monday, the last day of submission of application forms for first year (hons) classes (session 1995-1996).

Of the total forms 20,900 have been submitted for "Ka unit" (Science Faculty), 14,900 for "Kha unit" (Arts and Social Sciences Faculty), 14,500 for "Ga unit" (Commerce Faculty) and 20,900 forms have been submitted for "Gha unit" (Combined group).

On an average 15 students will have to contest for a seat in the admission tests for the first year (Hons) classes session 1995-1996 of Dhaka University.

Specially the examinees will have to face tough competition in "Gha unit". 29 students will contest for a seat under this unit. On the other hand the contest will be somewhat easy in "Kha unit". Nine students will contest for a seat under this unit.

Under the "Ka unit" 16 students will fight for a seat while the same

number of students (16 students) will fight for a seat under "Ga unit".

There are 4,000 seats under four units of Dhaka University.

Of them 1600 seats are under "Kha unit", 1300 seats under "Ka unit", 500 seats under "Gha unit" and the number of seats under "Ga unit" are 600.

There were 3,636 seats in the university under four units last year but recently the university authorities at a meeting decided to increase 10 per cent seats this year.

The admission tests for the first year (Hons) classes of Dhaka University will begin on May 9.

This decision was taken at a special meeting of General Admission Committee (GAC) on Saturday with Vice-Chancellor Prof. Emajuddin Ahmed in the chair.

According to decision of GAC, the tests of "Ga unit" (Commerce Faculty) will be held on May 9, "Gha unit" (Combined group) on May 10, "Kha unit" (Arts and Social Sciences Faculty) on May 17 while the test of "Ka unit" (Science, Biological science, and pharmacy faculty) will be held on May 24.
