DU teachers threatened by outsider

Teachers of Dhaka University Mass Communication and Journalism Department were threatened by one Jakir Hossain Jamal on Thursday when the teachers refused to give admission to a candidate who had got only 13 out of 100 in the admission test of M.A. First Part class.

Jakir Hossain Jamal allegedly entered the Chairman's office of the Department and pressurised him for admission of the candidate.

He also used the Department phone without any permission and (See Page 8 Col. 5)

stopped the Dean of Social Science Faculty Prof. Anwarulla Chowdhury from communicating with Dr. Siddiqui of the Department over phone.

After the incident, the teachers led by departmental head, Dr. Golam Rahman went to the Vice-Chancellor who assured them that an enquiry will be made immediately.

When contacted, Dr. Siddiqui who is also Joint secretary of DUTA told the Observer that teachers of the Department had been suffering from tense of insecurity since the incident.

Teachers of the Department in a joint statement on the day urged the Government, University authorities and the Dhaka University Teachers Association to take immediate steps against the person.
