BTA warns of tougher movement from June 1

Bangladesh Teachers Association (BTA) warned the government on Wednesday that they would go for a tough teachers' movement from June 1 unless their demands were met by then.

The association took the decision at its Dhaka Unit's meeting held on Wednesday.

Speakers at the meeting said that the District Education Offices, Education Board and especially the 'Shikkha Bhaban' had become a holy haven for corruption.

The teachers' demands include payment of 100 per cent of their basic salary, house rent and festival bonus by May 30 and implementation of the Revised Scale of Head Masters and Assistant Headmasters.

The Teachers' Association meeting was presided over by its President Md. Shahidullah and addressed, among others, by General Secretary Md. Selim Bhuiya, Md. Shahabuddin and Babu Sarker Paritosh.
