



SN Hall incident Probe body report not likely today

The one-member Judicial Inquiry Commission formed to probe into the July 23 incident at Shamsunnahar Hall of Dhaka University is unlikely SN Hall incident to file its report today (Wednesday) as per its deadline, reports UNB.

Talking to journalists, Justice Tafazzul Hossain, head of the commission, on Tuesday said that he has been working round the clock to complete the report and hand it over to the government. "Perhaps, it will not be possible to submit the report by today (Wednesday)," he said.

The commission, formed on July 27, started its functioning on July 28 and took statements of 72 teachers, students, police personnel and university officials. The government extended its deadline twice.

DU V-C holds talks with BCL leaders

Acting Vice Chancellor of Dhaka University Prof AFM Yusuf Haider on Tuesday held dialogues with the leaders of Awami League backed-Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) and JSD-backed Chhatra League to improve the campus situation.

In separate meetings with the student leaders, the university authorities urged them to extend their all out support to restore congenial atmosphere on the trouble torn campus.

BCL leaders at the meeting demanded immediate reopening of the dormitories and resume classes in the shortest possible time. They also demanded implementation of the general students' seven-point demands, exemplary punishment to those involve in the July 23 incidents at Shamsunnahar Hall, withdrawal of all cases filed against the students and rehabilitation of all legal students to their dormitories.
