CU teachers
vow to resist
fundamentalism

CHITTAGONG: July 2: The General Teachers Parishad today held a meeting with the cross section of people at the city's University Club to discuss the situation that crippled the academic life in Chittagong University.

Besides the University teachers, political figures, professions, cultural organisers, social workers and women organisers apathetic to fundamentalism attended the meeting.

The meeting discussed threadbare the present chaotic situation prevailing on the campus and possible means to resolve it. Among the prominent teachers who spoke at the meeting Emdad Khan, Dr. Anupam Sen, Prof. Abdul Mannan, Dr. Moiinul Islam, Dr. Mahzur Morshed Mahmud and Dr. Hamida Banu. The meeting took the decision to resist the fundamentalism and free the campus from the clutches of a particular student organisation.

Meanwhile, the Islami Chhatra Shibir continued to stage agitation in support of its demand for resignation of incumbent Vice-Chancellor Prof. Alamgir Mohammad Shirajuddin.

Meanwhile, a Senate member Prof. O.N.M. Munir Ahmed Chowdhury in a statement to the Press expressed surprise over calling annual meeting of Chittagong University Senate on July 7. He claimed that the holding of annual meeting of the Senate before that adjourned meeting was in contravention of provision of Senate working proceeding.
