Teachers rally tomorrow

Dhaka city unit of Teachers Liaison Committee will hold a rally in front of the Dhaka Board office tomorrow (Friday) at 9 a.m. in support of the four-point demand of the teachers of non-govt schools and colleges.

Leaders of the city committee in a statement on Wednesday urged teachers of the non-government schools and colleges of Munshiganj, Narayanganj, Narsingdi, Gazipur and Manikganj to make Friday's rally a success.

Meanwhile, central teachers liaison committee leaders held separate meetings with leaders of SKOP and Left Democratic Front (LDF) on Wednesday as part of their mass contact programme. During the meeting liaison committee leaders informed the SKOP and LDF leaders of their ongoing movement and said that teachers of the country's non-government schools and colleges have passed 45th days of their non-stop strike to press for four-point demand.

SKOP and LDF leaders expressed their solidarity with the movement of the striking teachers and assured them that they would extend full cooperation.
