About Tk. 2cr spent on mass literacy

Mr. Abdul Baten, State Minister for Education informed the Parliament on Wednesday that till now an amount of Taka 1,96,47,000 has been spent on mass literacy programme out of a total allocation of Taka 3.64 crore during the current fiscal year.

He was replying to a question by Mr. Nazrul Islam (Bakerganj) during question hour. Giving the break-up of the expenditure he said that Taka 1,87,40,000 was spent on books, Tk. 9,07,000 was spent on transportation and relevant purpose. The State Minister also informed the House that 80 lakh students were brought under the programme till
