## Three school boys hit by bullet in DU area

Four children including three school boys received bullet injury while they were walking through the road near British Council on Sunday morning.

They are identified as Mir Ahsan Kabir, a student of class three of

Udayan School, Tapas Khublal and John Pal of Nilkhet School and a street urchin Marzina Khatun.

Mir Ahsan Kabir, son of Mir Laikh Ali received bullet injury in his left leg. John Pal and Tapas Khublal, both are sons of the employees of Jagannath Hall received bullet injury in left hand and right leg respectively while the street urchin Marzina in the head.

All the injured children admitted to Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH). Later Mir Ahsan Kabir was shifted to a city clinic. Attending doctors operated upon John Pal and Tapas Khublal and recovered bullets.

There is confusion on how they were hit by bullets. Police on duty during the incident said the children were injured from the splinters of bombs thrown from the direction of Jagannath Hall while eye-witnesses said a group of youths aboard a microbus opened fire indiscriminately injuring the children at about 10:30 a.m. The miscreants left the place when the people raised hue and cry.
