



## **Shihab murder Two more accuse put on 3-day remand again**

Fazlul Haque and Rashedul Islam Rashed—two detained accused in the sensational schoolboy Shihab murder case were placed on fresh three-day police remand for interrogation by the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate (CMM) on Wednesday. Earlier the suspects were sent on week-long police remand for finding out the details of the gruesome murder of innocent schoolboy Shihab. Though the two killers—Litor Sayeed gave confessional statements under Section 164 of CrP before the Magistrate. Fazlul Haque and Rashedul Islam did not open their mouth in the first police remand.

On Wednesday, Detention Branch (DB) police produced two suspects before the Court with a prayer for three-day police remand. No lawyers submitted any bail petition for the accused. Metropolitan Magistrate Sirajul Haider put them on three-day police remand.

It may be mentioned here that thirteen-year-old schoolboy Shihab was kidnapped from the school gate on February 10 in the Motijheel area of the capital. The accused brought Shihab to their house. There, they murdered him brutally.

After murdering Shihab, the killers decapitated the body. Fifteen days after the killing, the Detention Branch (DB) police recovered the decapitated body of Shihab from the jheel of Goran and Barua. In this connection, on April 10, DB police arrested six persons, including Fazlul Haque and Rashedul Islam. They were for the second time in police custody on Wednesday.
