

## DUVC takes classes only to finish syllabus

Breaking the practice, the Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University is taking classes to finish the incomplete syllabus of the courses under him in the Department of Anthropology.

VC Anwarullah Chowdhury is now teaching the fourth and the final year (MSS) students in the Senate Hall at the university's Administrative Building.

After taking over the charge of the university's top executive post, Prof Chowdhury, widely known to his students as per the acronym of his name, AC, refused to hand over his classes to any other teacher, said a fourth year student of the department.

"Generally a Vice Chancellor does not find time to take classes. Previous VCs were under serious political and administrative pressure, so it was tough for them to take classes," said a teacher of the Anthropology Department.
