## DU to raise internal revenue

Authorities of the Dhaka University are now eager to increase its internal revenue generation instead of government allocation to accelerate the university's overall development activities.

This overture came from the university's vice chancellor on Sunday when he was laying the foundation stone of a residential building for accommodating the teachers and officers.

VC Prof Anwarullah Chowdhury said the universities in Europe, America and Australia have many sources of internal revenue. Of their total income, 50 per cent come from internal sources, he added.

The Dhaka University had to depend on only government allocation, as there is very little scope of revenue generation, the VC said adding, "which makes the development activities of the university slower".

The five storied building with ten flats will be constructed at Salimullah hall premises.

Pro-VC Prof Zinnatun Nesa Tahmida Begum, Treasurer Prof Syed Rashidul Hasan, Registrar Muhammad Selim, Director Planning and Development M Shahadat Hossain, Chief Engineer Amanullah Al Faruq, Executive Engineer M Mokhlesur Rahman attended the function. Provost of Salimullah Hall Prof M Nurul Islam presided over the programme.
