

## SAR rally on DU campus celebrate victory

Students Against Repression (SAR), the platform that led the late July student demonstrations, brought out a procession and held a rally on the Dhaka University campus on Sunday to celebrate their victory.

The SAR activists at the rally vowed to continue the movement till full realisation of their seven-point demands.

They said former Vice Chancellor and Proctor bowed out of their offices facing the students' outburst against the police actions at Shamsunnahar Hall at dead of night.

Despite the exit of the previous administration, the scenario remained unchanged, the speakers said and added that the terrorist organisations were given time to reorganise them by prolonging the closure of the university.

"We, the students, have to be united as the terrorists and their patrons corrupt politicians are united against us," said Taslima Tahrin.

Following the rally at Aparajeyo Bangla the SAR activists paraded the entire campus and terminated at Curzon Hall area.
