

Seats in DU halls for BCL activists demanded

Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) on Sunday submitted a memorandum to the Dhaka University Vice Chancellor demanding allotment of seats to the BCL activists in the dormitories.

The BCL activists held a rally in front of Arts Building before submitting the memorandum.

Leaders of the opposition student wing said after reopening of the residential halls some BCL activists were allowed to live in the halls.

The hall authorities then assured that the BCL activists would be allotted seats within the shortest time, but the BCL-men are yet to get any seat excepting in two halls.

They threatened further demonstration if the activists are not allotted seats immediately.

President of DU unit BCL Delwar Hossain and general secretary Hemayet Uddin Himu addressed the rally.
