



BCL protests closure of DUCA

Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL), the student wing of opposition Awami League, submitted memorandum to the Dhaka University authorities on Monday protesting the closure of DUCA, computer centre run by some students.

The BCL supporters submitted the memorandum after holding rally at Aparajeyo Bangla on the campus.

The BCL leaders told the meeting that the Dhaka University Computer Association (DUCA) was launched to introduce the latest information and communication technology to the university students. Students demanded to affiliate the DUCA into the university, but the administration did

not pay heed to the demand, they alleged.

The authorities put the DUCA under lock and key over a rumour of misappropriation of funds, they said. The corrupt persons must be punished, but closing the institution can not be the solution to an financial crime by any DUCA executive, they added.

As hundreds of students were benefited by DUCA, the authorities should reopen it immediately if any specific allegation is proved against any of the DUCA executives, the authorities should punish him, the leaders added.
