Assault on DU students

7 policemen sued

A teacher of Dhaka University (DU) on Tuesday filed a petition case in the CMM court accusing seven police officials of their alleged involvement in assaulting some teachers and students of the university in front of Rokeya Hall on July 29, reports BSS.

Sheikh Hafizur Rahman, a lecturer of the Law Department, on Tuesday submitted the petition case with Metropolitan Magistrate Sirajul Haider accusing the police officials and mentioning eight teachers and students of the university as prosecution witnesses.

Barrister M Amirul Islam, Advocate Syed Rezaur Rahman and Advocate Sahara Khatun along with a group of lawyers moved the petition to the court.

The MM after hearing the arguments of the lawyers asked the petitioner to submit his allegation to the judicial inquiry commission as the total incidents of the university are now under an investigation by a High Court Judge.

The accused police officials are

Kohinoor Miah, former Additional Deputy Commissioner (ADC) of the Detective Branch (DB), Ali Akbar, DC South, Abdur Rahim, former ADC South, Lutfar Rahman, former Officer-in-Charge of Ramna Thana; Mohammad Shahadat Hossain, a Sub-Inspector of Ramna Thana, constable Mosharaf Hossain(8852) of Ramna Thana and constable Shafiqul Islam (15655) of Riot Control Division.

The Prosecution Witnesses (PW) are Dr Mohammad Anwar Hossain, Head of the Department of Bio-Chemistry, Mohammad Moshirul Rahman, a lecturer of Sociology; Mesbah Kamal, Associate Prof. of History department, Samir Kumar Shil, Assistant Professor of Marketing Department, Professor M A Majid, head of the Surgery Department of Dhaka Medical College and Hospital, Professor M A Kader of unit four of Surgery and two students Mohammad Shafiqul Azam Rajon and Sabir Ahmed.
