No plan yet to
withdraw HSC
courses from
16 colleges

The government has no immediate plan to withdraw the HSC courses from 16 government colleges including Dhaka College.

When contacted Director General of Education Directorate, Prof. Hamida Banu told the Bangladesh Observer that there was no decision on withdrawing HSC courses from 16 government colleges as reported in a section of the press. She said the government has no plan to withdraw the existing HSC courses from the 16 government colleges including Dhaka College in the current academic session.

Dr Hamida Banu admitted that there were proposals to withdraw HSC courses from some selective government colleges where there are honours and masters degree courses. That decision too would depend on the shortages of teachers, class rooms, hostel accommodation, she said. She urged the guardians and the students not to be misled by any rumour or unconfirmed reports.
