

Anti-terrorism chain formed at DU

The general students of Dhaka University organised an anti-terrorism human chain on the university campus on Wednesday demanding immediate arrest and trial of the killers of Nuban Ahmed, a DU teacher who was recently killed by unknown miscreants.

Dhaka University Teachers' Association (DUTA) also expressed solidarity with the organisers and took part in the programme.

programme was also participated among others, by teachers, officers and employees of the university and members of anti-terrorism students' council, Dhaka University Alumni Association, Bangladesh Medical Association, Bangladesh Economic Association, Sammilitiya Sangskritik Jote, Society for Peace and Development and Jatiya Kabita Parishad.

The participants carrying festoons and placards with inscription of anti-terrorism slogans gathered on the campus and formed human chain around Arts Building, Modhu's Canteen, Central Library, Commerce Faculty Bhaban and Registrar building of the university at 10.30 a.m.

Nuban Ahmed, a lecturer of Dhaka University Economics Department was injured seriously when he was attacked by some unidentified hoodlums at the South Plaza of Jatiya Sangsad on December 17 and he succumbed to his injuries on December 26.
