

## Admission of 9 RMC students cancelled

**RAJSHAHI July 1:**—Admission of nine first year M.B.B.S. students of Rajshahi Medical College have been cancelled for adopting unfair means in admission. Among the students involved some submitted false marksheet at the time of admission. One submitted a marksheet of First Division though he had not at all passed the HSC examination.

After admission these students attended classes for about two months. Incidentally, these students did not attend their classes any more when the college authority learnt their misdeeds.

A criminal case will soon be started against these students, it is learnt from a reliable source.
