BPTITA blames training school teachers

Bangladesh Primary Training Institute Teachers' Association (BPTITA) blamed the teachers of the training schools adjacent to each PTI for hampering the dynamic activities of the association by giving false statement against BPTITA in the newspapers recently.

The BPTITA leaders at a Press conference on Friday at the National Press Club also said that the teachers of the training schools run by PTIs were proclaiming that they were equivalent to the instructor of PTI illegally.

They also said the instructors of PTI train the teachers of the primary schools while the teachers of the training schools adjacent to PTI teach the students of the schools, so their status can never be equivalent to the instructor.

It may be mentioned that there are training school adjacent to all the PTIs to train the school teachers who come to obtain PTI degree. In this schools the students can read from class one to class five.
