

BCL demands end to CU stalemate

CHITTAGONG, Aug 18:-Leaders of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL), Chittagong University unit, today placed six-point demands to ease the stalemate situation continuing on the campus from August 13 last, reports BSS.

The academic life of 14 thousand students of the university can not be in hostage by some armed cadres of ICS." BCL leaders said this in a Press conference held at a city hotel here this afternoon.

The demands are including formation a neutral probe body for investigating the incident of August 13 and July 17, immediately reopen the university, cancellation of the environment council formed with controversial persons, immediate arrest of the ICS cadres responsible for the incidents and removal the Provost of Abdur Rab Hall.

Nasir Haidar Babul, General Secretary of BCL, CU unit read out the statement while President of BCL, Zillur Rahman Jewel, Ali Murtaza, Kaiseruzzaman Azad, Shahidul Islam Bahar and Mahabub Elahi attended the Press conference.

The authority of the Chittagong University closed the campus for sine-dic and sealed all dormitories asking students to leave compus from August 13 after a clash between two rival student groups.
