

JCD sweeps JUCSU polls

SAVAR, July 7:— Jatiyabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) candidates won 86 posts out of 94 in the Jahangirnagar University Central Students Union (JUCSU) and six hall union elections held yesterday, according to provisional results announced here today, reports BSS.

Eight seats went to Chhatra Sangram Parishad, a combine of the six student organizations—Bangladesh Chhatra League (S-A), Jatiya Chhatra League, Bangladesh Chhatra Union, Bangladesh Chhatra League (N-S), Bangladesh Chhatra Maitree and Jatiya Chhatra Dal.

The JCD swept all the JUCSU posts.

M. Maniruzzaman and K.M. Rashedul Hassan Masum both of JCD were elected Vice-President and General Secretary respectively of JUCSU defeating nearest rivals

M. Jahangir Alam of BCL (S-A) and Hasan Mahmud Sajal of BCU.

Mohammad Mintu of JCD and Manash Kumar Chowdhury of BCU were jointly declared elected Literary Secretary of JUCSU as both of them bagged equal number of votes. They will hold the office for six months each.

Elected common room secretary of JUCSU Mohammad Ajmal Amin Tutul of JCD got the highest 976 votes.

JCD captured all the posts of Al-Beruni Hall, Mir Mosharraf Hossain Hall and A.F.M. Kamaluddin Hall Unions while the Sangram Parishad got VP, GS and four other posts in Nawab Fazilatunnesa Hall, VP post in Nawab Faizunnesa Hall and AGS seat in Salam Barkat Hall.

Meanwhile, Vice-Chancellor of the University Prof. Kazi Saleh Ahmed, in a statement, thanked the students, teachers, employees and members of the law enforcing agencies, deployed on the campus, for their cooperation in smooth holding of the elections.

Chief Election Commissioner of JUCSU polls Prof. Enamul Huq Khan also gave similar statement.
