Bangabandhu Agri University bill passed

A bill renaming the Institute of Post-graduate Studies in Agriculture at Gazipur as Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman Agriculture University was passed in Parliament Wednesday night in the face of a strong criticism from the opposition, reports UNB.

The Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman Agriculture University Bill 1998 was adopted by a voice rejecting more than 300 amendments moved by BNP and Jatiya Party members.

Winding up the discussion Agriculture Minister Begum Matia Chowdhury said the Institute of Post Graduate Studies in Agriculture (IPSA) was already upgraded to the University level in 1994.

The IPSA Board had unanimously resolved to rename the Institute as Bangabandhu Agriculture University. The teachers of the Institute took the initiative to show their gratitude to the father of the nation who had given the agriculturists a Class-I status.
