Slums adjoining Zahurul Haq Hall removed

Dhaka University authorities have removed the slums adjoining Zahurul Haq Hall as these were being used as a hideout for illegal drugs and arms by the terrorists.

Earlier, Vice-Chancellor Prof. A.K. Azad Chowdhury visited the spot a week back to see the condition there. Pro-Vice Chancellor Prof. Shahadat Ali and Proctor Prof. Noor-un-Nabi accompanied the VC.

Prof. Azad Chowdhury, as part of his efforts to remove terrorism from the campus, ordered the concerned authorities to take immediate action.

The authorities served a notice to the slum dwellers and as soon as the timelimit was over, they started removing the slums on Wednesday.

The demolition work had mostly been completed by Saturday.

Prof. Chowdhury, while talking to this correspondent, said, "all efforts will be taken to restore congenial academic atmosphere on the campus."

"As part of the efforts, the halls have been raided to nab the terrorists," he added.
