



DU teachers protest Israeli aggression

Teachers of Dhaka University on Tuesday demonstrated on the campus protesting the Israeli aggression and genocide in Palestine and the heinous attack on the civilians.

Some 50 teachers brought out a silent procession from Apurajeyo Bangla and paraded the campus streets with black banner. It was terminated at the Central Shaheed Mihar through holding a brief rally.

Dhaka University Teachers' Association (DUTA) President Prof AFM Yusuf Haider strongly condemned the Israeli aggression in Palestine at the rally and demanded immediate withdrawal of its troops from Palestine territories.

The DUTA President also demanded trial of Israeli Prime Minister Sharon for propelling the genocide on the civilians and urged the United Nations to play an effective role in establishing peace in the Middle East.
