

61 DU teachers demand repeal of Indemnity Act

Sixty-one teachers of Dhaka University in a joint statement on Tuesday called upon all members of the Parliament to take necessary steps to repeal the Indemnity Act, in the interest of the trial of the killers of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman.

They said that the rule of law cannot be established in the country where the "self-confessed" killers are moving freely. For the interest of establishing true democracy in the country the killers of Bangabandhu should be tried, they opined.
