FBUTA to observe work abstention today

The Federation of Bangladesh University Teachers' Association (FBUTA) will observe work abstention in the country's all universities and bring out silent procession today (Sunday) demanding removal of the National University VC Dr Abdul Bari for dishonouring the national anthem.

FBUTA, a combined body of the teachers associations of all universities, announced this programme on Saturday, says a Press release.

As part of the FBUTA programme, the Dhaka University Teachers' Association (DUTA) will bring out a silent procession from Dhaka University Aparajeo Bangla at 10 a.m.

DUTA General Secretary Dr Arifin Siddique has requested all members to make the programme a success.

Meanwhile, teachers of Dhaka University will go for two-day work abstention from today (Sunday) in protest against assault of teachers and ransacking of offices of Art Faculty Dean and Journalism Department Chairman by a group of armed youths on Thursday.

All examinations of the University will be exempted from this programme, says a DUTA Press release.
