

8 murder case

Killers now living in Shibir captured 3 CU halls: BCL

CHITTAGONG, Aug 7:- Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) leaders of Chittagong University (CU) unit today said that the terrorists who were involved in the last years eight BCL men murder case are now living in Islami Chhatra Shibir (ICS) captured three halls of the university.

This was disclosed in a Press conference that held in the office of Chittagong University Journalists Association (CUJA).

Zillur Rahman Jewel, the President of CU BCL read the written statement in the conference. The Press conference was addressed among others. General Secretary of CU BCL Nasir Haidar Babul, Shafikul Islam, Ali Murtaza Chowdhury, Belal Md. Nuri, Nazimuddin Md. Shimul, Shahidul Islam Bahar and Zahirul Ahsan Suman.

The BCL leaders said, ICS now assembling their cadres including the accused of eight BCL men murder case in their three captured halls of CU. These three halls are AF Rahman Hall, Alwal Hall and Suhrawardy Hall.

About the co-existence the BCL leaders said we wanted peaceful co-existence in the university halls. We always welcomed the legally allotted students. But in the name of co-existence or other way we will never allow ICS cadres to stay in the BCL leading halls. In another question, CU BCL President said that, there is not a single arms nor a single outsider in their occupied halls.

Talking about the recently formed Environmental Council (EC) of CU they said, there are some controversial persons included in the EC and for that reason we decided not to cooperate them. They also said that Dr. Md. Mahbub Ullah, the convenor of EC and member Dr. Md. Lokman are the most controversial persons in the EC.

About Dr. Md. Lokman of Finance Department BCL leaders said, this person of EC was involved in the making of blue print of killing BCL activists in near past. Is it possible for us to cooperate that EC in which this man included ? the BCL leaders questioned.

In the written statement, BCL

leaders submitted their five-point demands to the CU authority. These demands are arrest and punishment of those ICS men who are involved in the attack of four BCL men on July 27, arrest and punishment of those persons who were involved in the killing on the campus in the past, arrest of terrorists and recover of illegal arms from ICS captured halls, reform of EC with neutral persons and including of student organisations representatives in that and rehabilitation of general students in the three ICS captured halls of the university. They also threatened to go for greater movement if their demands were not met immediately.

On the other hand, while talking to The Bangladesh Observer CU ICS unit General Secretary Didarul Alam said, we are ready for the indefinite strike from August 10 if the CU authority does not accept our demands.

Meanwhile, Bangladesh Chhatra Union (BCU) today submitted a memorandum to the syndicate of CU to press home their four point demands. These demands are reshuffle of EC, withdrawal of ban on decision of all political activities of the university campus, trial of those persons who are engaged in the killing on CU campus and arrest of terrorists and recovery of illegal arms from the campus.
