

57 Pry school teacher posts vacant in Rajbari

RAJBARI, Aug. 8.—Fiftyseven posts of primary school teachers have been lying vacant for a long time in all four upazila of the district hampering the implementation of Universal Primary Education Programme. Official reports said of the total posts, 12 are of Headmaster and the remaining 45 are the posts of assestant teachers. It more be mentioned were that there are 261 government primary school and 55 private schools in the district. A total of 73556 students read in the government primary schools while 7052 students read in the primary schools.

The upazilawise vacant posts are: 10 in Rajbari Sadar 16, Pangsa 26 in Baliakandi and 5 Goainado upazila.

Beside the primary school which were damaged by floods and storms several years back have not yet been repaired. Roofs of 30 schools findings are in a dilapidated condition and tin shed house of 47 school have been damaged.

According to informed sources, the quota of teachers in government primary schools in the district is not maintained properly. Some schools with a large number of students are facing problems due to shortage of teacher while many school have no requisite number of students have extra teachers.
