## Posts of 29 teachers lying vacant in Madaripur College

MADARIPUR, Aug 130.—The construction work of 4-storied Hostel of Govt. N. College, Madaripur is going on in full swing.

Sheikh Shahidul Islam, Minister of Education laid the foundation stone recently in a ceremony attended, among others, by Mr. Serajul Islam Bhuiyan MP, and Chairman, Zila Parishad, Kazi Nasirul Islam, DC and Mr. Abul Kalam Azad, Principal of the college.

The construction work of the 2nd floor of the main two storied building at a cost of Tk. 13,54,000.00 is going to be started soon.

A wall in front of Principal's quarters at a cost of Tk. 1,35,000 is nearing completion. The wall collapsed in the last years devastating flood.

The approach road of the college and the college road is in a dilapidated condition.

There are 29 vacant posts of teachers including Vice-Principal, 3 demonstrators and a number of bearers. Classes are being hampered for want of teachers, and works in departments including laboratories for want of bearers it is gathered.

The foundation stone of the Tk. 32.30 lakh Zila Parishad complex was ceremonially laid by Sheikh Shahidul Islam, Minister of Education on August 23
