

BCL hails DU authorities for expelling Shamim

Pro-Awami Chhatra League (BCL) on Sunday hailed the Dhaka University authorities for expelling a BCL activist, Shamim Ahmed, reports UNB.

Authorities expelled two BCL activists, Shamim Ahmed and his rival Mainuddin Ahmed Babu, two months back for their involvement in armed clashes in Zahurul Huq Hall.

"We do not believe in terrorism. That's why we hail the university authorities for expelling Shamim," BCL's DU unit president Sajjad Hossain told a Freshers' reception in the Arts Faculty Building premises.

The rally that followed a procession was addressed, among others, by BCL leaders Bahadur Bepari, Ajay Kar, Khokan, Balaram Poddar, Sujit Roy Nandi and AKM Azim.

Shamim, known as "Pichchi Shamim" appeared in the rally to say, "all I did was for Chhatra League". BCL leaders hurriedly took him away from the rally before he could proceed further.

Later, Shamim told reporters that he had captured various dormitories in the interest of Chhatra League. I want to give up politics and live in peace," he added.
