DU admission test likely in 1st week of April

Admission tests for first year (honours) classes for the session 1998-99 of Dhaka University is likely to be held in the first week of April next, Vice-Chancellor of the University Prof. A.K. Azad Chowdhury told BSS on Sunday, reports BSS.

Prof. Chowdhury said selling of application forms for admission tests would begin from the second week of March and classes of the session would start from early July.

When asked how much students would be admitted this year, the Vice-Chancellor said the number of students would be the same like previous year (over four thousands), and the admission system (Multiple Choice Questions-MCQ) would not be changed.

Officials in charge of the admission test, said the admission committee, comprising dean of different faculties and senior teachers, would be constituted after the observance of the Ekushey February.

They said the authorities were thinking to start the admission process after the admission tests of Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET) and medical colleges scheduled to be held in late February.

Like previous years, the test will be held under four respective units—Ka for students of science group, Kha for students of arts group, Ga for students of commerce group and Gha for the students willing to change groups.
