DU exams to be held despite strikes

All examinations scheduled on October 13 and 14 of Dhaka University will be held despite strike called by some student organisations, reports BSS.

An emergency meeting of the Syndicate, held on Monday with Vice-Chancellor Prof A K Azad Chowdhury in the chair, decided to take all necessary steps for holding the examinations in a peaceful manner, a Press release of the university said.

The release said, around two thousand students of 18 to 20 departments are scheduled to sit for examinations on October 13 and 14 and if the examinations are not held, the schedule will be delayed for two months which will ultimately create session jam.

The Syndicate opined that the decision was taken considering the welfare of the students and the fame of the university. It also observed that earlier examinations were held despite the call of conventional student strikes.

The Syndicate urged all to co-operate with the university authorities for removing session jam and keeping the congenial academic atmosphere on the campus.
