Asiaweek Survey DU placed 37th position

Dhaka University has been placed at the 37th position in ranks among all the Asian universities which was revealed in a survey done by the Asiaweek Magazine. The university was placed in the 44th position last year.

The ranking is done on the basis of academic goodwill standard of faculty and students, financial and faculty resources research output and many other factors.

Considering all these criteria the University of Tohoku of Japan has been put at the top. Another Japanese university hit the second position in the chart while Seoul National University was placed in the 3rd.

The Jawaharlal Nehru University and Delhi University of India secured the 41st and 45th position respectively.

According to the facts revealed by the Asiaweek, published from Hongkok, the ratio of students and teachers is 18:1.

The Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University Prof. A K Azad Chowdhury while talking about the progress of the university in ranking said, "Our efforts to upgrade the standard of the university in all respects have achieved the success."
