



Rule issued upon DU

**Expulsion of 3
DU female
students**

Three students of Islami Chhatri Sangstha — Nilufer Yasmin, Farida Yasmin and Showkat Ara Khanam — filed a Writ Petition against Dhaka University, its Vice Chancellor and the Provost of Shamsun Nahar Hall challenging their expulsion from Shamsur Nahar Hall. Upon hearing their lawyer Barrister Abdur Razzaq, a Division Bench of the High Court Division comprising of Mr Justice K.M. Hasan and Mr Justice Khademul Islam Chowdhury issued rule upon the respondents to show cause as to why the expulsion notice dated 6 October 1999 issued by the Provost shall not be declared to have been made and issued without any lawful authority and is of no legal effect and why the respondents should not be directed to allow the petitioners to continue their lawful activities with Islami Chhatri Sangstha and profess, practice and propagate their religion Islam as guaranteed under Article 38, 39 and 41 of the Constitution and why the petitioners should not give full protection to continue with their studies in the University and go back to Shamsun Nahar Hall and reside there peacefully, says a Press release.
