Students damage Moitri hall dormitory

Students of Bangladesh-Kuwait Moitri Hall of Dhaka University on Monday damaged some windowpanes of the dormitory and detained one of the house tutors demanding what they called 'cessation of irregularities' in the hall, says UNB.

They brought out procession inside the dormitory and confined Salma Akhter, Assistant House Tutor of the hall, for 30 minutes from 8:25 p.m. at her office room. They declared that they would set free the house tutor after meeting the Provost and acceptance of their demands.

When contacted over telephone, the Provost of the hall could not be reached and the senior house tutors to talk with press. However, Salma Akhter told UNB by phone that the agitating students freed her and they were waiting for the Provost.

The girl students of the hall were bringing out procession at night for the last couple of days demanding summoning of general meeting immediately. They alleged that the house tutors do not attend their duties regularly.

Their other demands includes, repairing of the coin-box telephone, card-phone set of the hall and TV set, which were out of order for the last few months, and improvement of food quality of the hall. They alleged that the hall authorities are collecting Tk 200 as subscription from the guest students without providing receipts.
