

## **Transit to make internal security vulnerable: DUTA**

Dhaka University Teachers' Association (DUTA) has expressed concern over the government decision on transshipment of Indian goods through Bangladesh, reports UNB.

"It will make Bangladesh's internal security vulnerable and pave the way for outside interference into our sovereignty," DUTA president Prof AFM Yusuf Haider and General Secretary Ferdous Hossain said in a joint statement on Friday.

Besides, they said, the country's overall economy, including road infrastructure, will be affected.

They said the government should have discussed the matter in parliament and sought public opinion before taking such an important decision that involves the country's security and economy.

They urged the government to reconsider the decision in the greater interest of protecting the nation's economic interest and for the sake of its security and stability.
